





Antidepressants may increase suicidal thoughts or actions in some children, teens or young adults within the first few months of treatment or when the dose is changed. Depression or other serious mental illnesses are the most important causes of suicidal thoughts or actions. People who have (or have a family history of) bipolar illness, or suicidal thoughts or actions may have a particularly high risk. It is the reunion with her daughter Sara that mum Gillian never dreamed would happen.

Six years ago after becoming an alcoholic, former air hostess Gillian McFarlane, 48, was forced to give daughter Sara up to live with her dad and his new wife in Italy. Sara was just five and giving her up broke Gillian's heart. She began drinking even more and ended up in hospital with Cirrhosis of the liver. Doctors warned she could die – but then she thought of her daughter and the thought of abandoning her again – by dying – gave her the strength to get

better.

Denise can you write to all those who kindly participate in the episode Prescription for Murder.


